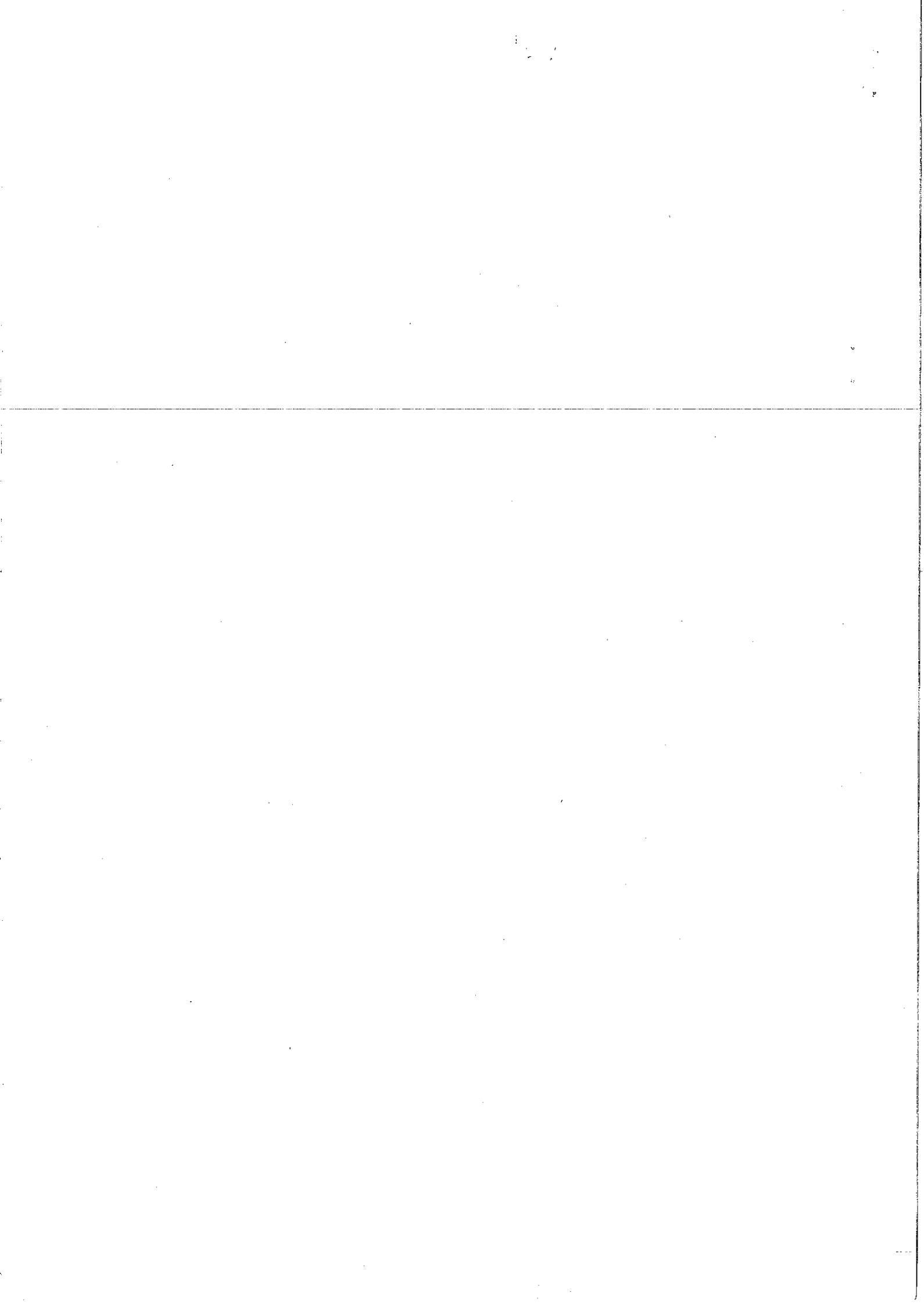



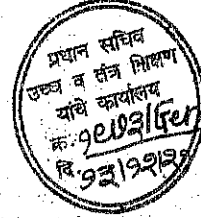

Since five decades this Board has been implementing National Apprenticeship Training Scheme (NATS) in the Western Region of India which comprises of the states of Maharashtra, Gujarat, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, and Goa as well as Union Territories of Dadra Nagar Haveli, and Diu-Daman. Under the NATS the fresh Graduates, and Diploma holders in the Engineering/Technology, Pharmacy, Architecture, and Hotel Management and Catering Technology, are imparted one year's 'on-the-job' training as Graduate, and Technician apprentices respectively as per the provisions of The Apprentices Act 1961, (as amended in 1973). For enhancing the employability of the students of general streams, the apprenticeship training has now been extended to them through the Apprenticeship/Internship Embedded Degree Programme (A/IEDP). As the Board of Apprenticeship Training has been liaising the industry with the institutes for implementing NATS, the Ministry of Education has given the responsibility to find out the Universities and institutes where A/IEDP programmes can be started from the Academic Year 2021-2022. The Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education implements the National Apprenticeship Training Scheme (NATS) through four regional Boards of Apprenticeship/Practical Training (BOATs/BOPT) located at Kanpur, Kolkata, Mumbai & Chennai. At present, the scheme is available only to B.Tech and diploma holders in engineering. Details of NATS can be seen at the website www.mhrdnats.gov.in. Further, keeping in line with the Budget announcement 2020 by Union Government, it has now been agreed by University Grants Commission (UGC) that the scope of apprenticeship training can be expanded to include students pursuing non-engineering degree and diploma programmes as well. The objective of such expansion is to facilitate students pursuing general programmes like B.A/B.Sc./B.Com to get practical exposure to commercial world as a part of their course curriculum and improve their employability.

2. The UGC guidelines for Apprenticeship/Internship Embedded degree program is available at [https://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/9105852_ugc-guidelines ApprenticeshipInternship.pdf](https://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/9105852_ugc-guidelines_ApprenticeshipInternship.pdf). UGC has also requested Central/State/Private Universities of the country to come forward and take measures to introduce Apprenticeship/Internship embedded degree program in their University for the larger interest of our students (copy attached).

3. The Boards of Apprenticeship Training play a crucial role in mediating between the Universities and Industry in trying to bridge their mutual interest and help them come together to develop industry/commercial courses for general students pursuing BA/B.Sc/B.Com or diploma level programme. The four BOATs/BOPT together with Sector Skill Councils and other stakeholders are already working on it. They have also been asked to find out the preparedness of colleges & universities for implementing these degree programs from the academic year 2021-22.


4. You will appreciate that employment is one of the main thrust area of the government. To achieve this, the students who opt general programmes like B.A/B.Sc./B.Com in respective



College/University need to be encouraged to take admission in Apprenticeship/Internship Embedded degree program so as to improve their employability. Through this letter, you are requested to kindly exhort the state universities to give full attention to developing apprenticeship/internship embedded course by getting in touch with The Boards of Apprenticeship Training. The contact details of four Boards are attached herewith.

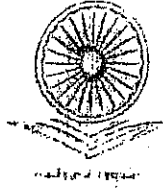


Madam / Sir,

As you are aware, in order to capitalise on India's remarkable demographic dividend, it is essential not only to improve the quality of education but also to make it relevant in terms of providing employment opportunities. The competencies demanded by the industry need to be embedded in our university curriculum so that the employment-employability gap is overcome. The minimal linkage between the general degree curriculum and employer's requirement calls for an effective remodeling of degree programmes, driven by changing needs of the industry and service sector. Apprenticeship and internship can play a significant role in this context. World over, apprenticeship is considered as the most efficient and promising structured training for exposure to the real working environment. Realising the importance of apprenticeship/internship, the Budget Announcement of 2020-21 set out for the introduction of Apprenticeship Embedded Degree/Programme to improve employability of general stream students.

In line with the Budget Announcement and with the objective of making the fresh graduates employment-ready with necessary knowledge, competencies and attitude, Hon'ble Education Minister, Government of India recently launched the UGC Guidelines for Higher Education Institutions to offer Apprenticeship/Internship Embedded Degree Programme for embedding apprenticeship/internship in general degree programmes offered by the Universities. A copy of the Guidelines is attached herewith. Considering the interests of the students and society at large you are requested to kindly promote apprenticeship/internship embedded degree programmes in your University as well as the colleges/institutions affiliated to your University.
