Greetings from All India Council for Technical Education...!

It is with great pride and gratitude, the council acknowledges all the stakeholders for their unflinching commitment and support rendered in all the initiatives of AICTE particularly in the Approval Process 2021-22. It is worth highlighting that the council is working meticulously on various measures for the quality improvement in Higher Educational Institutes, notably in Institutions offering Technical Education. It is also worthy to record that the Approval Process of 2021-22 had some major and effective changes as advocated in the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

It is seen that during the Approval Process 2021-22, many institutions Universities have made use of the policy changes which are inline with NEP 2020 such as *Introduction of new course(s) in emerging area(s) / Increase in intake in emerging area course(s) / introduction of OL&ODL course(s) / Introduction of regional language Course(s), etc.* It is noteworthy from NEP perspective a holistic and multidisciplinary education will help to improve quality of Technical Education. The communication in this regard should be sent ONLY through online form available @ [https://facilities.aicte-india.org/survey/nomenclature\\_APH.php](https://facilities.aicte-india.org/survey/nomenclature_APH.php) with necessary details such as detailed syllabus, resolution, etc. so as to reach AICTE latest by 15-10-2021.
